


How to remove the leak standard

-Remove the black plastic plate on the top of the unit.

-Use a T10 screwdriver to remove the 4 screws under the black plastic plate



-Use a T20 screwdriver or a 3mm allen wrench to remove the 2 screws on the back of the unit




- -Use a 2.5mm allen wrench to remove the 2 screws that connect the leak standard.
- -Send in the leak standard only. Make sure it is well packaged, it is extremely fragile. Double box the leak standard with bubble wrap or foam.
- -Follow these instructions in reverse to install the newly calibrated leak standard once you receive it back.

When reinstalling the leak make sure the black O-ring is clean and installed where the leak standard connects.




Programming the new leak standard valves

- -Select the supervisor icon
- -Select logoff



- -Select login
- -Type Service in Login
- -Type 0130 in PIN
- -Select LOGIN in the green circle



- -Select: Diagnosis>Service>Setting>Calibration Leak Internal
- -Enter the new value from the leak standard
- -Select the circle icon in the lower right-hand side of the screen to save the new valve

- -Select: Setting>Setup>Maintenance Counters
- -Enter the "calibration leak" value for one year from the stated date on the newly calibrated leak.
- -Select the circle icon in the lower right-hand side of the screen to save the new valve
